#### Preschool Program Updates for 2024-2025

With the opening of more classrooms, Highland Park ISD will no longer have a district preschool waitlist and has decided to move in another direction with enrollment that is similar to enrollment processes at other schools in the area.

The district is hosting a Preschool Parent Preview session on Thursday, October 10th at 8:30 am at the Clements Leadership Center, next to Highland Park High School. The preview session should be announced through social media on or after 09-25-2024. This is an opportunity for parents who are interested in registering their child for the 2025-2026 school year to learn more about the program. After the parent session is finished, then registration will open for next school year.

You do not need to attend the session to register your child, but it will help answer any questions you might have about preschool in Highland Park ISD. More information regarding registration will be put on our district website and through social media channels after October 10th.








#### Armstrong Yearbook: we want your photos for the 2024-25 Armstrong Eagles Yearbook!
